REGULATIONS

ORGANISATION

RULES

The ITTF rules shall be applied with the non-essential unavoidable exceptions.

ELIGIBILITY

The Championships are open to all players of Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania table tennis associations/federations, who are 40 years of age at December 31st 2019 or elder. Proof of age must be available on request.

CATEGORIES AND EVENTS

o Categories for Women's Singles and Men's Singles:

- 40-44 years (born 1979 or earlier).
- 45-49 years (born 1974 or earlier).
- 50-54 years (born 1969 or earlier).
- 55-59 years (born 1964 or earlier).
- 60-64 years (born 1959 or earlier).
- 65-69 years (born 1954 or earlier).

- 70-74 years (born 1949 or earlier).
- 75-79 years (born 1944 or earlier).
- 80-84 years (born 1939 or earlier).
- over 85 (born 1934 or earlier).

o Categories for Women's Doubles and Men's Doubles:

- 40-49 years (born 1979 or earlier).
- 50-59 years (born 1969 or earlier).
- 60-69 years (born 1959 or earlier).
- 70-79 years (born 1949 or earlier).
- 80 or over years (born 1939 or earlier).

ENTRIES

Preliminary entries – not later than April 7 „on line“ website www.stalotenisas.lt

Entry fee 20.00 EUR.

Payment in cash until 13th April, 09:50. Gala dinner – 15.00 EUR.

SYSTEM OF PLAY

- Every entered player is allowed to participate in one singles and one doubles event.
- A player must participate in her/his own age category, except in doubles if the players of a pair do not belong to the same age group, in which case they shall have to compete in the category of the younger player.
- Each category singles and doubles will be played best of 5 games. Consolation competitions also will be played best of 5 games.
- If there will be 7 or more players or pairs in an event, there will be played the Qualifying Competitions in groups by 4 (3) players or pairs. The first and second placed in qualifying groups will play the Championships Competition according to the single knock-out system. The other singles from qualifying groups will play in Consolation Competition knock-out system.
- For doubles consolation competitions will not be played.
- If there are less than 4 players or pairs in an event, they will play in younger Age Category, but awards will be given in all categories.

DRAW

The draw will take place April 13th from 10:00.

UMPIRES

- The Organiser will provide umpires for the Championships Competitions.
- In the Consolation Competition, the looser of the match, shall umpire the next match at the table, where he or she have played.

EQUIPMENT

- Tables „CORNILLEAU“ blue.
- JOOLA PRIME 3*** ITTF 40+ white balls (ABS plastic) will be used.
- Racket covering must be ITTF authorise.

PRIZES

First places in singles will receive a cups and gold medals, second places silver medals and semi-finals losers bronze medals. First places of the consolation singles event in each Category will receive medals.

First places in doubles will receive a gold medals, second places silver medals and semi-finals losers bronze medals.
